LU REES ARCHIVES MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The committee meets six times a year and oversees the Archives.

Kath Cobcroft, Chair is Bibliographic and Metadata Librarian, University of Canberra Library. She advises on cataloguing matters, and is an active member of the Children's Book Council ACT Branch.

Dr Belle Alderman AM, Collections Development Manager & Treasurer has been involved with the Archives from its inception. Now retired, she volunteers a minimum of two days a week and manages the strategic directions of the Archives.

Gaynor Evans, Secretary was formerly the Archives' Administrative Officer from Oct 2005 – May 2008, and now works at Literacy for Life in the ACT. She advises and participates in Archives' projects.

Margaret Carmody, Australian Catholic University Representative is Academic Skills Adviser and Disability Adviser and was previously lecturer-in-charge of *Children's Literature for Literacy* and *Literature for Children and Young Adults*.

Victor Crittenden, Emeritus Chair was the Librarian at the then Canberra College of Advanced Education who, in 1980, supported the proposal to house the Lu Rees Archives at the College Library. He set up the Management Committee in 1983 and has remained a member.

Lynn Fletcher, ACT Community Liaison, recently retired from her position as the Institute Librarian at the Canberra Institute of Technology. She was previously Secretary of the Committee. She has a long involvement with the CBCA and the Lu Rees Archives.

Belinda Gamlen, Lu Rees Archives, Administrative Officer is the current Administrative Officer at the Lu Rees Archives and is responsible for the day-to-day administration.

Kathryn Ginn, Committee Member is Associate Librarian, University of Canberra, and is the chief liaison between the Archives and the University Library.

Judy Horswell, National Library of Australia Representative is Manager (A/g), Australian Contemporary Collecting, Australian Collections Management & Preservation Branch.

Rebecca Kemble, President, Children's Book Council of Australia ACT Branch is the conduit between the Archives and members of the CBCA (ACT). Rebecca was the Lu Rees Administrative Officer from 2001 until June 2005.

Julie Long OAM, Committee Member is immediate past President of the CBCA (ACT), and currently is its Membership Secretary. She plays an important role in organising the Archives' working bees and functions.

Anna McCormack, Journal Editor was appointed Honorary Editor in July 2010. She brings 20 years' experience as an editor, was previously a public librarian for nine years, holds a Masters in children's literature and has reviewing and creative writing publications. She is the ACT Judge for the CBCA national awards for 2012-2013.

Sarah Steed, Programs Manager, ACT Libraries and Representative of the ACT Libraries.

Julie Wells, National President, The Children's Book Council of Australia (CBCA) receives the Minutes and comments on the Archives' proceedings.

LU REES ARCHIVES HIGHLIGHTS OF 2011

The Lu Rees Archives Management Committee gratefully acknowledges the University of Canberra Library's generous support since 1980. The Library provides facilities, cataloguing, expertise, and other in kind support. We also acknowledge the annual donation of \$1500 from The Children's Book Council of Australia (CBCA) ACT Branch. The CBCA's National Executive has funded, since 1993, the part-time position of the Lu Rees Archives Administrative Officer. Currently, this position supports the Archives' endeavours through 14 hours weekly for 46 weeks annually.

The Archives continues its contribution to AustLit: The Resource for Australian Literature, the web-based database covering Australian literature from 1780 to the present. Ten Australian universities and the National Library of Australia collaboratively provide bibliographic records and index Australian literature in print and electronic sources. In 2000, the Archives initially provided 12,000 bibliographic records and thereafter indexed works by and about literature for young people, thereby adding to the profile and knowledge base of Australian children's literature.

The Archives' initial collection held 1000 books and 60 research files. We now hold 21,240 books including 2,672 translations and 402 research files. This year 1,338 books were donated, including 280 translations in 24 languages and 12 serial titles. There were 16 monetary donations among donations from 16 authors and illustrators, 25 publishers, and 21 individuals and organisations. See Appendix 4, Donations for details.

Under the Cultural Gifts Program this year, the Archives accepted a third collection of artwork and related papers from the internationally recognised creator, Bob Graham. The Archives now holds the world's largest documented collection of his work.

In 2009 the Archives Funding Group began. It continues to submit grants and seek sponsorship. During 2011, two reports, *Assessment of Significance* and *Preservation Needs Assessment* were completed with funds from a Community Heritage Grant. Archives' collections deemed significant included its book collection post-1960, translations, research files and authors' and illustrators' papers, manuscripts and artwork. These reports will guide the Archives' future endeavours. The Archives received a grant from the ACT Seniors and Sponsorship Program, enabling a project using Australian children's literature to promote wellbeing and social interaction within the retirement communities, Kangara Waters and Calvary. The Archives' year-long campaign to raise money for cataloguing 470 overseas translations in 32 languages succeeded with a private donor, Scholastic Australia, the Australia-Japan Foundation, Scandinavian Association and nine Embassies providing funds.

The Archives continued its commitment to promoting Australian children's literature with secondary students, University of Canberra students studying graphic design, writing for young people, and literary studies, as well as Australian National University adult students studying picture books. The Archives' educational focus also included working with the Canberra Institute of Technology's Museum Studies students and psychology students from Shukutoku University in Japan.

The Archives' major achievement this year involved the Emily Rodda events held between 23-25 March around national Harmony Day. Over 500 children heard Emily Rodda speak, and an audience of 200 adults attended her lecture on 'Children's Books in Many Languages'. The event celebrated the completion of our translations project, and featured an exhibition of Rodda's manuscripts, Australian children's books in many languages, and a selection of the Archives' framed artwork.

1 BRIEF HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In 1974, when a Commonwealth Government grant of \$500 was made to each Branch of The Children's Book Council of Australia, the ACT Branch began a collection of biographical files about Australian children's authors and illustrators along with a collection of their books. Lu Rees, then president of the ACT Branch, proposed this idea to all the Branches, who agreed. As a beginning, Lu Rees donated her personal collection of some 500 books. Members of the ACT Children's Book Council added to both the book collection and the files over the years.

In 1979, to celebrate the International Year of the Child, Lu Rees proposed that the collection should include translations of works by Australian children's authors and illustrators. Publishers, authors and illustrators donated whatever books were available. The exception was Ivan Southall's personal collection of 83 volumes, which the Branch purchased with a grant from the International Year of the Child Committee. Southall's collection in 2011 numbered 237 volumes, featuring many variant editions and translations. Emily Rodda is presently Australia's most translated author. The Archives holds her complete body of work, including 674 editions of her works in 32 languages.

By 1979, the collection as a whole had grown to some 1000 books and 60 files of materials about authors and illustrators. Increasingly, requests were received to use the collection, but this was difficult as the collection was housed in the homes of Lu Rees and other Branch members. The time had come to consider a future home for the collection. While various ideas were discussed, Belle Alderman suggested the Canberra College of Advanced Education Library as a possibility. Victor Crittenden, the Librarian at the College, fully supported the idea. A more public location would mean that students, researchers and the community could have easier access. Negotiations began with the Librarian and administrators of the College.

The Chairman of the College Council, Douglas Waterhouse, accepted the collection at a ceremony held on 15 July 1980. Conditions of use and access were informally agreed upon by both parties, with the Children's Book Council ACT Branch to retain ownership of the collection and the Library to house, catalogue and provide support in various ways. At that time, the collection was formally named the Lu Rees Archives in honour of its founder. In 1988 the Archives gained deductible gift recipient status, renewed in 2000, and also classification as a tax-exempt charity. By 2011, 34 donations of authors' and illustrators' papers, manuscripts and artworks have been accepted under the Cultural Gifts Program. The value of these exceeded \$1,000,000 in 2009. A formal agreement was drawn up between the ACT Branch and the University of Canberra (formerly the College) in June of 1991 and renewed in October of 2003. The Agreement detailed sponsorship support by the Library, management responsibilities, access, security, and outlined termination and dissolution arrangements. In 2008, background information relating to the Lu Rees Archives, its legal standing and ownership, and the support provided by the National Executive of The Children's Book Council of Australia was added to The Children's Book Council of Australia's *Procedures Manual*. This Manual is the official guide for The Children's Book Council of Australia's National Executive. The *Lu Rees Archives Policy Documents* are regularly revised and approved by the Lu Rees Archives Management Committee. The latest is the *Lu Rees Archives of Australian Children's Literature Strategic Plan 2011-2015*. These guide collection development, consider priorities and outline future directions.

2 COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT

2.1 Research Files

In 2008, the Collections Development Manager reported on the then existing 317 research files on authors, illustrators, and others in the Australian children's book industry. The research files, dating from the 1970s, are unique and judged 'unmatched' and 'significant' by an external expert. They are a large time and staff commitment. The Archives uses 30 distinct categories to classify each item which also receives a unique number. New files take a minimum of four hours to research and prepare. Updating existing files may take up to 10 hours. Tasks involve researching relevant items, classifying these, photocopying degradable material, alphabetising, filing and entering each item on a database. Presently, the Archives' database is no longer operable, and we are diligently researching solutions.

The Archives' Management Committee will be considering a second review of the research files in October 2011. The results will be reported in the next annual report.

Below are the 23 new files, which have been researched and created this year, making a total of 402 research files. New authors and illustrators are always emerging and existing files continue to grow.

Only a few research files are comprehensively updated each year, although we are constantly adding material to files. The 10 files updated this year include Jeannie Baker, Terry Denton, Libby Gleeson, Morris Gleitzman, Andy Griffiths, Melina Marchetta, Matt Ottley, Emily Rodda, Shaun Tan and Markus Zusak. Those chosen for updating meet a range of criteria.

2.2 Finding Aids

Materials have been arranged and described for the collection donated by Nan Hunt (a.k.a. N L Ray) in 2007. We are grateful to Gaynor Evans and later Lynn Fletcher for their work in creating this finding aid. It is a particularly rich collection spanning 27 works over 27 years, and featuring many different editions and translations. The author had extensive contacts within the children's book industry, which makes this collection particularly invaluable to researchers. Nan Hunt has assisted the Archives in completing our collection of her books in every edition. 2.3 Books, Serials and Special Donations

The Lu Rees Archives receives donations of books and serials from publishers, authors, illustrators, individuals, the ACT Branch of the CBCA and other organisations. These make a significant contribution to the Archives' research capacity. This year the Archives received 1,338 books, of which 280 were overseas editions. Appendix 4, Donations, provides details.

Throughout the year we received a number of special donations. These have included overseas editions of works by Melina Marchetta, Ruth Park and Deborah Niland in languages including Slovenian, Korean, Japanese and Finnish. Overseas editions of P L Travers' *Mary Poppins* titles, Paul White's Jungle Doctor series and additional Emily Rodda titles have also been received. Several books in *The Sanitarium Children's Library* arrived complete with stickers. Children eagerly collected stickers from packets of Weetbix to paste into these books, which were published in the 1940s and 1950s.

Jane Eldershaw, the daughter of Elisabeth MacIntyre, donated four of her mother's books to the Archives. The text of one of the titles, *The Willing Donkey*, had been amended in pencil to reflect 'proper English'.

Rafe Champion, husband of Kilmeny Niland, donated the artwork from four books illustrated by Kilmeny including *Pancakes and Painted Eggs*, *The Fairy Tale Picture Dictionary*, *The Gingerbread Man* and *The Ugly Duckling*.

The ACT Branch of the CBCA provided funds to purchase second-hand titles from the Lifeline Book Fair, Canberra's largest second hand book sale. Many gems are found there, thanks to Angela Brown who 'spots' books on behalf of the Archives. This year we received several classic Australian books by Mrs Aeneas Gunn (*We of the Never-Never* titles), Ruth Park (*Muddle Headed Wombat* titles) and May Gibbs (*Snugglepot and Cuddlepie* titles).

Eleven books in Indigenous languages have been added to the Archives' collection. These books are from the Milingimbi Literature Production Centre and the Yirrkala School Literature Production Centre. They are in the Gupapuynga, Durilji and Gumatj languages.

The Resource Services and Academic Services (reference materials) teams in the Library have catalogued and supervised cataloguing of over 1100 items in the last year (25 September 2010 to 29 September 2011). Through special funding, CAVAL catalogued 470 overseas translations as part of this 1100 total. We are grateful to the Library staff for their continued cataloguing efforts of the Archives' books.

2.4 Cultural Gifts Program

The Archives was fortunate to add a third consignment of Bob Graham's artworks, papers and manuscripts this year. The entire collection has been detailed on our artwork frameworks and rehoused in archival enclosures. For more details of Bob Graham's donation, please see Appendix 4, Donations.

2.5 Wish List

A new Wish List of 34 Hesba Brinsmead titles has been uploaded onto the Lu Rees Archives website (<http://www.canberra.edu.au/lu-rees/donations/wishlist>). The Colin Thiele Wish List has been retired to a less prominent position on our website (<http://www.canberra.edu.au/lu-rees/donations/wishlist/thiele-wishlist>), although we would be very pleased to receive more of these missing titles.

3 ACCESS

3.1 AustLit: The Resource for Australian Literature

The Lu Rees Archives (representing the University of Canberra) continues to be a partner in the AustLit project. AustLit is a non-profit collaboration between 10 Australian Universities and the National Library of Australia, which provides

authoritative information on creative and critical Australian literature works relating to more than 130,000 Australian authors and literary organisations. Its coverage spans 1780 to present day.

AustLit provides access to a web-based index of over 730,000 records of works (books, articles, reviews, criticisms etc) and more than 130,000 records of agents (authors, illustrators, publishers, reviewers etc), all relating to Australian literature (September 2011 figures).

Each institution adds and maintains records, and is responsible for particular publications. The Lu Rees Archives is responsible for part of the children's literature section, and so indexes some of the journals that relate to this. These journals are *Reading Time*, *English in Australia*, *The Newsletter of the Centre for Youth Literature*, *The Dromkeen Society Bulletin*, *The Horn Book Magazine*, and *The Lu Rees Archives: Notes, Books and Authors*. In addition to these journals, other works such as new books, new authors and illustrators, theses, reports, awards and author biography updates are also indexed.

Between September 2010 and end of September 2011, the Administrative Officer added or updated 539 works (books and reviews) and 143 agents (authors, illustrators and publishers).

3.2 Newspaper Project

Last year's annual report commented on receiving two large donations of newspaper and journal clippings. This project has been tackled and completed by our valued volunteers. The largest collection came from Lynne Babbage, a teacher librarian whose collection began in 1981. It was widely used by her students and teachers in secondary schools. The other large collection came from Dr Kerry White, who collected clippings for use as an author of bibliographies of Australian children's literature, contributor to *The Source* and for her many articles and reviews on Australian authors and illustrators.

While the Internet and online databases have made online retrieval of material much easier, such coverage is inevitably not comprehensive. Earlier years are rarely indexed, and databases often lack contextual material and exclude illustrations. Indexes also rarely pick up smaller publications, unlikely sources and obscure items, which our avid clippers invariably found. Once received in the Archives, our process involves photocopying acidic materials as these deteriorate and damage our collection, then categorising, labelling and filing these in individual files. We are very grateful to these dedicated collectors whose clippings have greatly strengthened our research files.

3.3 The Lu Rees Archives: Notes, Books and Authors

The Lu Rees Archives: Notes, Books and Authors is published annually and distributed to over 500 individuals and organisations, including authors, illustrators, and publishers, and school, university and State libraries. The 32nd Issue, 2010 was distributed this year. It contains a range of articles including the 'adventures' of *Little Miss Anzac: The True Story of an Australian Doll* and "Collaborating with Steven Woolman on *One Child*" by Christopher Cheng. 3.4 Stock Take

In May this year two of our dedicated volunteers, Rose Howes and Marlene Campbell, began a manual stock take of the Archives' book holdings. This is the first time a comprehensive stock take has been undertaken. They are uncovering a number of issues including books that have no catalogue records, incorrect accession numbers, creative shelving, and missing books (though some of these are later found shelved incorrectly). During the stock take they have been checking that edition information is correct and where books have been signed by authors and illustrators, this is included in the cataloguing record.

4 SERVICES TO CLIENTS

4.1 Clients

There was an increase of 7.4% in the number of clients assisted by the Administrative Officer and the Collections Development Manager. This year we have assisted 422 clients who have contacted or visited the Archives. The time spent with clients increased from 131.652 hours to 188.04 hours - a 42.8% increase.

The clients who contact the Archives are varied and include authors, illustrators, donors, teachers, students (primary and high school, college, and tertiary), researchers, university staff, and members of the public. The majority of requests to the Archives this year were from within Australia. The most common contact with the Archives was a visit. Other forms of contact include emails, phone requests and via our closed access form. For full details of the requests and clients who are using the resources provided, please see the table at Appendix 3.

4.2 Volunteer Contributions

Volunteers play an extremely important role in the everyday management and operation of the Archives. This year our valued regular volunteers continued to make a major contribution to the ongoing development of the Archives. We were also fortunate to have a number of new volunteers who offer specialist expertise.

As in past years the number of volunteer hours worked has continued to rise. The figures in the table below show a 21.7% increase in the total hours worked by volunteers. The 2449.34 hours (2013.28 in 2010) worked by volunteers is equivalent to 350 days full time equivalent or over 15.2 months (based on a seven hour day and an average of 23 working days in a month). Table 1 below also provides brief descriptions of the types of tasks that volunteers undertake.

5 PRESERVATION AND CONSERVATION

5.1 Artwork Project

The Artwork Project is steadily progressing. The arranging, describing and rehousing of artwork collections is a highly detailed process. Artwork proformas have been completed for works from books illustrated by Bob Graham (9 titles), Rodney McRae (3 titles), Kilmeny Niland (2 titles), Pixie O'Harris (1 title) and Leigh Hobbs (1 title).

The Archives houses The Children's Book Council of Australia's Children's Book Week artwork. The artworks developed by Kylie Dunstan (2010) and Gregory Rogers (2011) have been described and rehoused.

The artwork frameworks enable the Archives to gain physical and intellectual control over artwork held by the Archives; achieve a record of holdings; ensure easy storage and retrieval; avoid frequent handling of artwork; provide public information about the Archives' holdings; and facilitate research into and public exhibition of the artworks.

5.2 Significance and Preservation External Reports

A Community Heritage Grant awarded at the end of 2010 provided funds for two external experts to assess the Archives' significance (historical and cultural

importance) and preservation needs. Both reports are invaluable for charting our future and in seeking grants and support for various endeavours.

The *Lu Rees Archives of Australian Children's Literature: Assessment of Significance* states that the Archives 'has established a firm reputation among researchers, students, bibliographers, librarians and the general public as one of the most important collections of children's literature.' The report concluded that the Archives 'has performed an important role in fostering an awareness of and enthusiasm for Australian children's literature in the general community.' The report identified these areas as significant and commented:

- book collection post-1960 is comparable to National and State Libraries
- translated works are among Australia's strongest
- 400 comprehensive research files on authors and illustrators are 'unmatched' in Australia
- manuscripts and artworks feature Australia's most important creators and is of considerable value to researchers studying artistic development
- resources are open access, which is valued by researchers.

The report recommended digitisation of several collections for access and preservation including the Walter McVitty Photograph collection, a collection of 117 unique audiocassettes, and The Children's Book Council of Australia's Children's Book Week artwork.

The *Preservation Needs Assessment: Lu Rees Archives of Australian Children's Literature* assessed the preservation needs of our collections which had been deemed significant and, as well, commented on the collections, environment and physical condition of the Archives' space. The major recommendations were to:

1. expand space for the collection
2. digitise collections deemed significant
3. develop a conservation plan for the Children's Book Week artwork
4. create dedicated storage for framed artworks
5. complete rehousing for parts of the collection
6. separate over-full research files
7. offer preservation & awareness training for Archives' staff and volunteers.

The Archives staff have discussed both reports with the University Librarian as there are some recommendations over which the Archives has no control. The Archives has discussed items 1 and 4 with the Library. Item 3 will be discussed with the CBCA National Archivist and the National Executive of the CBCA. Item 5 requires additional staff resources which we presently do not have. Item 6 has now been addressed and item 7 is already in practice. Item 2 will be addressed, over time, through monetary donations, grants and collaborations with various institutions. The *Preservation Needs Assessment* included a detailed five-year Action Plan. Based on this 41-page report, the Archives has created a working plan which identifies needs, recommended solutions, priorities and charts progress. It will guide action over the next three years. The report is scheduled to be discussed at the December Lu Rees Management Committee meeting. The Library has generously provided an additional compactus for storage of our collections, for which we are very grateful. Some of the specific recommendations in this report cannot be addressed within the current space and resources available to the Archives.

6 MARKETING AND PROMOTION

6.1 Display Cabinet

A new display cabinet has been provided by the University of Canberra Library for use by the Archives. The cabinet sits outside the entrance to the Archives and its changing contents have attracted visitors to the Archives. Items on display have included CBCA shortlisted books, the CBCA Award winners, *Forests of Silence* by Emily Rodda in 17 different languages and Australian Christmas titles.

6.2 Website

Significant changes have been made to sections of our website. The home page has been updated and now includes a welcome statement and a short visual presentation about the Archives. Author and illustrator finding aids are now available via links from several pages. A new page containing information on the Emily Rodda event and a photo gallery have been added. Information and photographs have been updated and links to websites checked and updated.

Due to a change in the provider of the website statistics, data is only available for the period 4 August 2011 – 30 September 2011. In this period there have been 557 visits, with 2.07 pages viewed per visit. The average time on site is 1.09 minutes.

The five most visited pages in this single month are: Welcome to the Lu Rees Archives; the Author-Illustrator Index; Websites on Children's Literature; and The Emily Rodda Event 2011.

The 557 visits to the website came from 27 countries. The majority of visitors are from Australia, followed by the United States, United Kingdom, Russia, Indonesia, Philippines, Italy and India.

6.3 Educational Visits

Educational sessions have been conducted for groups of students at both high school and tertiary level on a range of topics. Sessions have included:

- Professional experience visits by tutors and students from Library and Information Management courses at Box Hill Institute and RMIT, Victoria, and Charles Sturt University;
- Picture book creation for Graphic Design students from the Australian Business College, picture book illustrators and techniques for The Centre for Continuing Education, Australian National University and Years 11 and 12 students from Radford College, ACT;
- Tours and information sessions about the resources housed at the Archives for students studying Literature for 0-18 years at the University of Canberra;
- Picture books in English and Japanese for Shukutoku University, Japan psychology students studying English; and
- Conservation of objects for Museum Practice students at the Canberra Institute of Technology

6.4 Emily Rodda Events

The Emily Rodda events over March 23, 24 and 25 were associated with the national celebration of. We were also celebrating the completion of our year long project to catalogue overseas translations. We spent a year campaigning to raise funds to hire

CAVAL, professional cataloguers, to catalogue 470 translations in 30 languages. Donors to this project included Rodda's publisher, Scholastic Australia, a private donor, the Australia-Japan Foundation, nine Embassies and the Scandinavian Association. The Archives holds 2672 overseas translations in 53 languages. These have been judged significant and one of the strongest collections in Australia. Emily Rodda is Australia's most translated children's author, and we formally accepted the donation of her papers and manuscripts along with the complete collection of her works in 674 editions.

Over Rodda's three days in Canberra, she spoke to a packed audience of 200 people at the University's new Ann Harding conference centre on the topic, 'Australian Children's Books in Many Languages'. She also talked with 220 children in years 4 and 5 at Radford College, and to over 250 children and the general community at the National Library of Australia. Two young people, aged 11 and 15, interviewed Rodda with style and intelligence. The audience was totally engaged. Refreshments and a book signing followed. The National Library said it was their longest book signing queue on record. Rodda was also interviewed on two radio stations, featured in several newspaper articles, in numerous newsletters and on various websites. Over 650 in the Canberra community 'met' face to face with this amazing ambassador for children's literature. 6.5 Promotion

Over the year, the Archives featured in a number of different media. We appeared in print, magazines, newspapers and journals, on the radio, in a blog and on twitter. The Emily Rodda event described above attracted a wide range of publicity from event advertising to interviews in print and on radio with Emily Rodda. The Community Heritage Grant received by the Archives attracted publicity in a number of sources, including one by Gai Brodtmann MP in a Constituency statement in the House of Representatives on 1 March 2011.

7 CURRENT AND FUTURE DIRECTIONS

7.1 Grants and External Funding

Each annual report provides an opportunity to re-examine the Archives' current and future developments in terms of past performance and future prospects.

An external Funding Group, with membership including the Archives staff, was set up in late 2009 as a result of the CBCA National President's report. Between January 2010 and September 2011, this Group has sourced and applied for grants and sponsorship to support the following projects: preserving and promoting original artwork for research and exhibition purposes; cataloguing of overseas translations; using Australian children's literature to promote reminiscing, social interaction and personal well-being within retirement communities; creating awareness of Australian Children's literature in Spanish translations; determining significance and preservation needs to provide a blueprint for future development; offering a festival of Australian children's literature in many languages; documenting and accessing Lu Rees Archives files; designing and curating a retrospective exhibition of the artwork of Bob Graham including an associated educational program for the community; digitising audiotapes about Australian children's literature to preserve and provide access; and offering a festival of Australian children's literature in partnership with ACT Libraries and the ACT Writers Centre. The total amount requested was \$176,000 with \$28,950 secured. Several of these grants were for the Bob Graham retrospective exhibition. While we received offers of sponsorship and some funds for

this exhibition, we were unable to raise the amount of funds required, which was disappointing.

Sourcing grants and writing the applications, and where successful, managing and acquitting them, is enormously time consuming. The success rate for grants for non-profit organisations with part-time staff is generally 10-15 per cent. Grants are highly competitive. Usually no feedback is provided when a grant is unsuccessful. Our rate of success is somewhat disheartening; however, we will continue to apply for grants as these provide essential funds for important initiatives. Grants cannot secure funds for our most urgent need, which is for full-time staff.

Annual funding by the National Executive of the CBCA for part-time staffing of the Archives since 1993 has been critical to our achievements. We are very grateful for this ongoing support.

7.2 Future Directions

We constantly seek opportunities for collaborative projects with institutions and make links with academic programs at the University of Canberra, Australian National University, the Canberra Institute of Technology and elsewhere. These serve our educational focus, publicise the Archives' resources, activities and events and provide mutual benefit to each institution.

In 2011, the Archives published its third strategic plan, *Lu Rees Archives of Australian Children's Literature Strategic Plan 2011-2015*, which recommends the establishment of a foundation, along the lines of that created for the CBCA Book of the Year Awards. That *Strategic Plan* is available on the Archives' website at http://www.canberra.edu.au/lu-rees/publications/strategic_plans. The thinking is that once the funding goal has been secured, interest on the invested funds can produce the majority of funding required for a full-time Administrative Officer and a part-time Collections Development Manager. The December meeting of the Lu Rees Archives Management Committee this year will discuss and finalise our Action Plan for 2012.
