NOTES:

- 1 For the purpose of charging fees, graduate certificates, graduate diplomas and masters courses are considered to be discrete courses, even where they belong to a suite of courses. Accordingly, students who upgrade from a graduate certificate to a graduate diploma to a masters course will be charged at the annual rate applicable for the year in which they commence each course (see note 3, below, for further information).
- 2 A 'closed' status indicates that a course is not open for new admissions in 2010.
- 3 The University of Canberra sets its fees according to an annual rate method. The annual rate is the fee that applies to standard full-time enrolment, which is 24 credit points. The final fee charged is based on the proportion of 24 credit points in which a student enrolls. For example, if a student only enrolls in 3 credit points then the student will be charged $3/24 = 0.125 \times$ annual rate. In 2006 the University changed its fee charging method. The annual rate that applies in the year a student commences will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration). Students who commenced in 2005 or pre-2005 will be charged the 2005 annual rate. The only exception to this rule is postgraduate research students. If a postgraduate research student is charged tuition fees then the tuition fee rate approved each year will apply to the student. (i.e. the fees are not fixed and may vary from year to year).
- 4 The 2006 annual rate will apply to all students who commence study in a degree in 2006. The 2006 rate will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
- 5 This is the total course fee that will apply to students who commence study in a degree in 2006.
- 6 Student Contribution Amount.
- 7 The Executive Master of Public Administration is offered in partnership with the Australian and New Zealand School of Government (ANZSOG) and has restricted entry.
- 8 The 2007 annual rate will apply to all students who commence study in a degree in 2007. The 2007 rate will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
- 9 This is the total course fee that will apply to students who commence study in a degree in 2007.
- 10 The Graduate Certificate in Physics Education is offered in partnership with the Department of Education and has restricted entry.
- 11 The 2008 annual rate will apply to all students who commence study in a degree in 2008. The 2008 rate will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
- 12 This is the total course fee that will apply to students who commence study in a degree in 2008.
- 13 The 2009 annual rate will apply to all students who commence study in a degree in 2009. The 2009 rate will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
- 14 This is the total course fee that will apply to students who commence study in a degree in 2009.
- 15 The 2010 annual rate will apply to all students who commence study in a degree in 2010. The 2010 rate will apply until the student completes the degree (as long as the student completes in standard part-time enrolment duration).
- 16 This is the total course fee that will apply to students who commence study in a degree in 2010.
