The University of Canberra has introduced a bonus point scheme for students studying year 12 at schools within NSW.

This scheme applies to schools throughout rural and regional NSW but does not include the ACT or Sydney Metropolitan.

- Eligibility is based on the school's postcode NOT a student's residential address.
- We provide UAC with the postcode range. They automatically add **5 bonus points** to any student with an application to study at UC and who studied year 12, during the current year, at a school with a postcode from our list.
- Students do not need to apply for the bonus points, they are allocated automatically.
- Bonus points can not increase a student's rank above 100.
- The bonus points can easily be identified on an applicant's file within UAC.
- The bonus points apply to all of our undergraduate courses.
- Bonus points are limited to applicants currently studying year 12 (CSL – current school leavers).
- These bonus points are independent of any other bonuses that students may be eligible for.
- Students will be able to confirm that they have received the bonus points by contacting the University of Canberra and providing their UAC application number.
- Not available to students who have deferred an offer.
- Not available to students studying year 12 at TAFE.
