Freedom of Information Access Application Decision Notice
Our Reference 220007

I refer to your application under the [Freedom of Information Act 2016 \(ACT\)](#) (the Act), received by the University of Canberra (the University) on 26 December 2021, for access to the following information:

- (a) all original data from respondents to the University of Canberra's Respect.Now.Always survey;
- (b) a copy of the Respect. Now. Always. document referred to as *Methodology individual reports*; and
- (c) a copy of the Respect. Now. Always. document referred to as *University of Canberra data*.

Authority

I am the Information Officer appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University to make decisions in respect of Freedom of Information (FOI) applications, in accordance with section 18 of the Act.

Decision

Item A

Following extensive enquiries, I have concluded that all original data from respondents to the University of Canberra's Respect.Now.Always survey you have sought access to is not held by the University. I have made this decision in accordance with section 35(1)(b) of the Act.

The University understands that the original survey responses were collected by the Australian Human Rights Commission. Accordingly, I confirm the University holds no records that pertain to Item A within the scope of your FOI application.

Items B and C

I have identified the two records pertaining to Items B and C within the scope of your FOI application. I have decided to grant full access to these records. I have made this decision in accordance with section 35(1)(a) of the Act.
