Exemption to the Conflict of Interest Policy

A Preservice Teacher (PST) may apply for an exemption to the Conflict of Interest Policy at their host school if:

- ✓ they have been employed at the school longer than 2 years (as at start of placement) OR are
 approved by TQI / NESA# to hold a Permit to Teach as a final year preservice teacher at their host
 school,
- ✓ they have not had a placement previously at the school,
- ✓ they will not be mentored by a family member or close friend/relative employed at the school,
- ✓ they have not been a student at the school in the last 6 years,
- ✓ they are undertaking their FINAL level placement at the school,
- ✓ they will NOT be undertaking paid employment duties at the school for the duration of their placement, and
- ✓ that they are not placed in classes they are currently teaching and they are fully mentored by a supervising teacher throughout their placement.

#With respect to PSTs completing their final placement at a NSW school where they have conditional accreditation, NESA have an application process known as a 'Waiver B.' However, as UC is in the ACT we are subject to TQI's requirements for final placements in a school where a PST is employed. These are:

- Students may undertake their final year placements in the school where they are employed as long as no previous placements have been undertaken in that school;
- The normal responsibilities of the placement mentor as outlined in the document, Roles And Responsibilities in the UC Professional Experience Program, including support for the student to complete their Teacher Performance Assessment, will be met in the case where the student undertakes a placement in the school where employed.

STEPS FOR REQUESTING AN EXEMPTION TO A CONFLICT OF INTEREST

1.	Preservice Teacher reviews the exemption criteria
2.	Discuss upcoming placement with host school
3.	Submit an exemption to Final Placement request form (<u>Forms & Documents: All Teacher Education Students (canberra.edu.au)</u>
4.	The Faculty of Education will determine the suitability of the request as per the approval criteria and placement requirements
5.	Faculty of Education will advise Placement team if request is approved
6.	Student notified of placement approval/rejection
7.	Host school sent confirmation of placement details/rejection of placement request
