## ENGAGE WITH WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING (WIL)

UC Internships are integrated into the curriculum and can be undertaken at any time during the academic year. Students undertake independent, professionally orientated activities (duration varies in each program of study). Supervisors are encouraged to treat interns as they would staff and give them tangible and productive work where they can contribute and learn. All internship commitments are formalised through official university agreements. Because the internship is a recognised part of a UC degree student insurance is generally covered by the University for the duration of the placement. All our programs comply with the requirements of Fair Work Australia.
