University of Canberra (Parking and Traffic) Rules 2015

made under the

University of Canberra Act 1989, s 40 (Statutes), s 41 (Statutes about Traffic) and University of Canberra (Parking and Traffic) Statute 2015

1 Name of instrument

These rules may be cited as the University of Canberra (Parking and Traffic) Rules 2015.

2 Commencement

These rules commence on the date of approval by Council.

3 Purpose of these Rules

Traffic and parking controls set out in these Rules provide for paid parking areas within the University grounds designated by Council as carparks where motorists will be required to pay for the time they occupied the University carpark.

4 Paid parking areas

The areas designated by Council as paid parking areas are labelled boomgate parking at Schedule 1.

The foregoing Rules are made by Council under sections 40 and 41 of the *University of Canberra Act 1989* and the *University of Canberra (Parking and Traffic) Statute 2015*.

In making these Rules the University had regard to the provisions of section 40B(1)(b) of the *Human Rights Act 2004*.
