LIQUOR STATUTE 2015 <i>(Replaced Liquor Statute 2011)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Insertion of Explanatory Memorandum setting out relationship between Liquor Act and UC's ability to regulate sale and purchase of alcohol on campus• Transfer of key functions to Rules• Removal of provisions which allow possession and supply of liquor to persons under 18
PARKING AND TRAFFIC STATUTE 2015 <i>(Replaced Traffic Statute 1995)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Updated to include current ACT Road Transport legislation requirements and campus parking arrangements
OBLIGATIONS STATUTE 2015 <i>(Replaced Obligations Statute 1995)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provides a delegation power for the Vice-Chancellor• Allows for appointment of an Obligations Officer• Provision for the creation of rules to which the operative provisions have been transferred

<p>STUDENT CONDUCT RULES 2015 <i>(Replaced Student Conduct Rules 2012)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updated definitions e.g. serious misconduct • Updated provisions on procedural fairness • Updated grounds for appeal • Restrictions placed on the number of appeals allowed • Excluded students no longer have the right to appeal directly to Council • The Vice-President Operations has the ability to immediately exclude or suspend a student in emergency situations • A hearing of the Committee is no longer required where an obvious error has occurred at Summary Inquiry and this can be corrected on the papers alone where in favour of a student
<p>LIQUOR (GENERAL) RULES 2015 <i>(Replaced Liquor (General) Rules 2012)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elimination of Liquor Permits for faculty/staff events • Introduction of a Special Function Permit where supply and/or sale of alcohol takes place at large events • Large events and special functions where liquor is sold or supplied must be catered by a licensed caterer or permit holder under the <i>Liquor Act 2010</i> (ACT) (Note: The Union meets these criteria.) • Removal of provisions allowing UC to issue liquor permits to private outlets • Requirement that all sales of liquor must be through permit or license holders under the <i>Liquor Act 2010</i> (ACT) • Only Council can approve the issue of a liquor permit
<p>LIQUOR (UCU) RULES 2015 <i>(Replaced Liquor (UCU) Rules 2012)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes a map of Union Premises • Retains but limits the <i>Liquor Act 2010</i> (ACT) exemptions to accommodate the campus commercial operations of the Union
<p>PARKING AND TRAFFIC RULES 2015 <i>(New Rules)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes a campus map identifying campus parking
<p>OBLIGATIONS RULES 2015 <i>(New Rules)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides for administrative functions to be performed by the Obligations Officer and Vice-President Operations rather than the Vice-Chancellor
