ELIGIBILITY

This tour is exclusively available to students who are currently pursuing a Bachelor of Midwifery (HLB001) or a Bachelor of Nursing (364JA) in their third year. Enrollment in Continuity Midwifery A (11299) or Health Across the Lifespan: Child and Family Health (10196) is also a requirement. Please note, this tour is not a placement. While international students are welcome to apply, they are not eligible for funding and must cover all expenses themselves.

To be eligible you must also have a passport with at least six months of validity beyond the planned stay.
