OUR COMMUNITY


Whilst the University of Canberra was established within the boundaries of the Australian Capital Territory, our community extends across the world.

OUR TRADITIONS

GRADUATE GOWNS

Today's academic dress developed from the clothing worn by the monks in medieval times. The monks and pupils taking instruction wore habits or long gowns with a cowl (a hood and elbow-length cape), both indoors and outdoors, for extra warmth. Later, tonsured monks wore skull caps, probably for the same reason. At Oxford and Cambridge, in the time of King Henry VIII, statutes prescribed what style of academic dress could be worn. The rules were strictly enforced. Materials and colours to be used for hoods to denote levels of scholarship were laid down, and later, colours for hood and gown trimmings were used to indicate particular branches of learning.

Academic dress for the University of Canberra draws on these traditions. Graduands undertaking Bachelors and Masters degrees wear a black cloth academic gown, black trencher and hood. The dress for a degree of Doctor is a royal blue gown with gold facings and a black bonnet. The level of award is distinguished by the colours of the hood linings, rather than by colours for different branches of learning. This carries on the tradition established by the Canberra College of Advanced Education (CCAEC).

In completing your studies, you have earned the right to wear these ceremonial robes.

CEREMONIAL UNIVERSITY OF CANBERRA GOWNS

The gowns of the Chancellor and Vice Chancellor celebrate Canberra. They feature the floral emblem of the Australian Capital Territory, the Royal Bluebell (*Wahlenbergia Gloriosa*), on a decorative braid. Embroidery on the braid showcases the natural, deep-blue shades of the Royal Bluebell flower, which grows in the high forests and woodlands of the ACT, south-eastern NSW, and eastern Victoria, and its dark-green stems and leaves. The braid was designed by Ms Judith Rosenberg from sketches by Dr Dianne Firth, a University of Canberra staff member, and made by Dr Sharon Peoples, a respected local textiles artist. Both gowns are traditional black. The Chancellor's gown has gold trimmings and the Vice Chancellor's is trimmed with silver.

The Chair of Academic Board and Division Marshals wear black gowns with bands of deep-blue embroidered braid and a hood lined in deep-blue. Council members wear an adaptation of the former CCAE's purple ceremonial gown, as a salute to our history.

GOWNS IN THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The academic procession for each ceremony, led by the Chancellor, includes many of the academic staff of the University, including lecturers and tutors. The procession is rich with different styles and colours of academic gowns from institutions across the world. The regalia worn by each member of the procession signifies where each person studied for their highest level of qualification, and which degree was conferred.





SYMBOLS OF THE UNIVERSITY

The authority of the University of Canberra to confer degrees is embodied in several ceremonial and symbolic artefacts. You will be familiar with the C-Star, as it appears on many University publications, but the other symbols – the Chair, the Mace, and the Staff – are rarely seen outside graduation ceremonies.

The Star

Our emblem, the C-Star, was designed with the CCAE's original purpose in mind, which was to provide education in the five fields of science, technology, art, administration, and commerce. These five broad areas are embodied in the five interlocking "C's". The C-Star represents Canberra, the interdisciplinary nature of our courses, and the essential character of each field of endeavour. In 1969, the CCAE Council commissioned the design from Derek Wrigley.

Chancellor's Chair

The Chancellor's Chair was a gift from the Australian National University, marking the inauguration of the University of Canberra in 1990. This ceremonial item was crafted at the Canberra Institute of the Arts. The chair's back proudly bears the University's emblem, the C-Star. Traditionally, only the Chancellor or their representative may be seated on this chair. This ceremonial item marks the solemnity of our Graduation Ceremonies and represents our emergence as a global educational institution. It provides a link between our past success as CCAE, the recognition by our peers of our achievements, and our continued success as the University of Canberra.

Mace

The Mace is carried by the Secretary of Council. The Mace was presented to the University by the ACT Government in 1991, as a symbol of institutional authority. Traditionally the Mace is carried as a ceremonial weapon designed to protect the Chancellor, the University, its people, and its processes. Like the Chancellor's Chair, it was crafted at the Canberra Institute of the Arts.

Processional Staff

The Processional Staff is carried by the Chair of Academic Board. The Staff, like the Mace, is a traditional ceremonial symbol of authority. Ours was presented to the University by its Association of Academic Staff. It is made of wood from a local Casuarina tree and embellished with silver. It was crafted at the Canberra Institute of the Arts to harmonise with the Mace. The jarrah stand on which the staff rests was crafted and donated in 2012 by former University of Canberra staff member, Peter Hill.



HONORARY DOCTORATES

EMERITUS PROFESSOR THOMAS CALMA AO FANZSOG FAA FASSA FAHA

DOCTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY

**Hon DLitt CDU, Hon DSc Curtin, Hon DUUniv Flin,

Emeritus Professor Thomas Calma AO is an Aboriginal elder of the Kungarakan tribal group, a member of the Iwaidja tribal group, and has been a tireless champion for improving the lives of all Australians, in particular the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians.

With a long and distinguished career spanning five decades, Professor Calma has advanced Australia as an inclusive society through his work as a human rights and social justice campaigner in the fields of education, training, employment, health, justice reinvestment, aged care and economic and social development. He has worked as a diplomat, race discrimination commissioner and social justice commissioner, and remains a policy advisor, academic and altruist.

Professor Calma served as a senior Australian Diplomat in India and Vietnam from 1995 until 2002, advancing Australia's education and training interests, and was later appointed Senior Advisor for Indigenous Affairs. He served as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Social Justice Commissioner at the Australian Human Rights Commission, and as Race Discrimination Commissioner. As Social Justice Commissioner, he reported to Parliament on issues facing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, highlighting the discrepancy in life expectancy between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians.

Professor Calma's 2005 Social Justice Report on Indigenous health equality was the catalyst for the Close the Gap campaign advocating for governments to commit to eliminating the discrepancy within a generation. In 2008, in his response to the

Federal Parliament's national Apology to the Stolen Generations, Professor Calma said, 'By acknowledging and paying respect, Parliament has now laid the foundations for healing to take place, and for a reconciled Australia in which everybody belongs.' In October 2019, Professor Calma was appointed with Professor Marcia Langton AO to Co-Chair (and subsequently re-appointed to implement) the Voice to Parliament Co-Design process, and became a champion and advocate to enshrine a body in the Constitution that would enable Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to provide advice to the Parliament on policies and projects that impact their lives.

Professor Calma has been involved in and with the tertiary education sector since 1980 as an academic, in representing Australia's interest in all education sectors internationally, on research grants, in reviewing administrative and academic structures and on advisory boards and committees at eight universities. Professor Calma is a member of the Australian Universities Accord Implementation Advisory Committee and is a Professor of Practice at the University of Sydney, an Adjunct Professor at the University of Queensland, an Adjunct Associate Professor at the Australian National University and Honorary Professor at Macquarie University. The University of Sydney has awarded him an honorary doctorate of letters.

Professor Calma is Co-Chair of Reconciliation Australia, Chair of the not-for-profit organisation Ninti One Ltd and Patron of the Poche Centres for Indigenous Health Network. Since March 2010, he has performed the role of National Coordinator, Tackling Indigenous Smoking to lead the fight against tobacco use and vaping in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. He is an inaugural Trustee of the Charles Perkins Trust that funds scholarships for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples to Oxford and Cambridge universities. He is also Co-Chair of the Australian Literacy and Numeracy

Foundation, Chair of the Living First Languages Platform Co, a member of the Australian Medical Research Advisory Board, Australian Genomics Independent Advisory Board and the Aged Care Council of Elders.

Professor Calma's list of honours and awards for his contributions to human rights, social justice, government policy and reform, cross-cultural understanding, and education is extensive. In 2012, Professor Calma was awarded an Order of Australia; Officer of the General Division (AO) and named ACT Australian of the Year 2013 for his service and commitment to the Indigenous community as an advocate for human rights and social justice. In 2016, Professor Calma received the Martin Luther King Jr Memorial Flag Award on the 240th anniversary of the United States of America's independence. In 2022 and 2023, Professor Calma became a Fellow, Academy of the Social Sciences in Australia, Fellow of the Australian Academy of Science (being the first Indigenous person elected to the Academy) and Honorary Fellow of the Australian Academy of the Humanities. In 2023, he was named the ACT and national 2023 Senior Australian of the Year.

Professor Calma's influence on the University of Canberra has been immense. He became a member of the University of Canberra Council in 2008, was Deputy Chancellor from 2012, and served as the University's sixth Chancellor from January 2014 until December 2023. He was the first Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander man to hold the position of Chancellor of any Australian university.

In his quiet and respectful manner Professor Calma guided the University of Canberra community to tackle difficult issues and to establish its identity as a values-led University, aiming to be the most accessible university in Australia and a global leader in driving equality of opportunity. He championed the role of Indigenous peoples at all levels of the University, including launching UC's Collaborative Research Initiative (UC CIRI) in 2014.

It is for his distinguished career in social justice and his outstanding reputation as a leader of both the University and in the national arena that Professor Calma AO is being awarded an Honorary Doctorate by the University of Canberra.

COUNCIL
