- name and student number of the endorser; and
- contact student email of the endorser.

Candidate Statement and Photo

You may provide a statement in <u>Word format</u>, including photo, for publication on the election website in support of your candidacy, up to a maximum of 500 words. Where a statement exceeds 500 words, only the first 500 words will be published.

The Returning Officer may request a candidate to amend their statement if it contains inappropriate content (e.g. defamatory or discriminatory statements) and may withhold that content from publication if the candidate refuses to amend the statement.

It is <u>required</u> that you provide a photo to be published with your candidate statement. The Returning Officer must approve any photo prior to publication.

Lodgement of Nomination Form, Candidate Statement and Photo

Nominations must be received by the Returning Officer by no later than **5:00pm Friday 29 August 2025.** Please email the completed nomination form, candidate statement and photo to elections@canberra.edu.au. Receipt of nominations will be acknowledged by email.
