Candidate Statement and Photo

You may provide a statement in <u>Word format</u>, including photo, for publication on the election website in support of your candidacy, up to a maximum of 250 words. Where a statement exceeds 250 words, only the first 250 words will be published.

The Returning Officer may request a candidate to amend their statement if it contains inappropriate content (eg defamatory or discriminatory statements) and may withhold that content from publication if the candidate refuses to amend the statement. The Returning Officer must approve any photo prior to publication.
