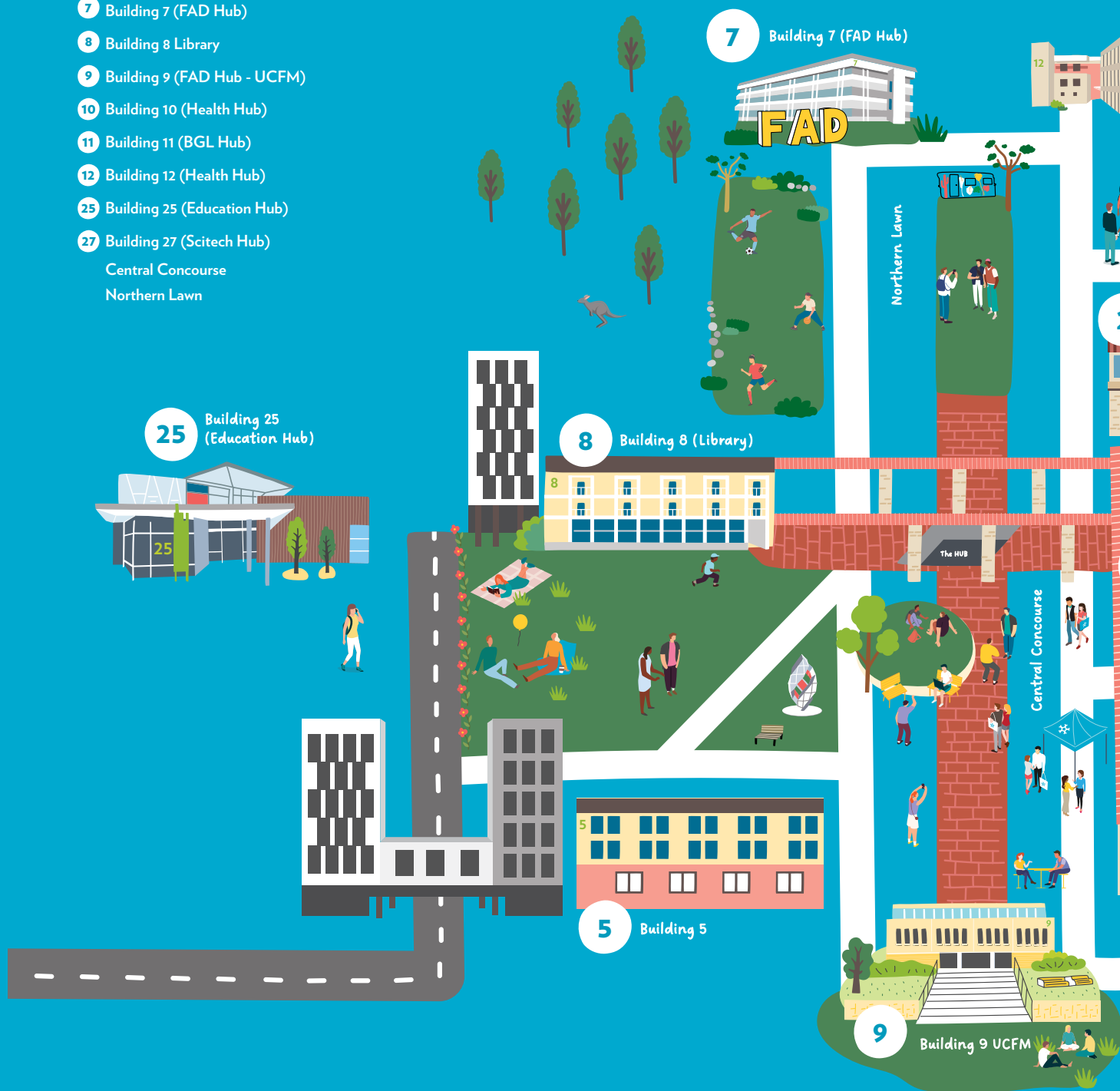

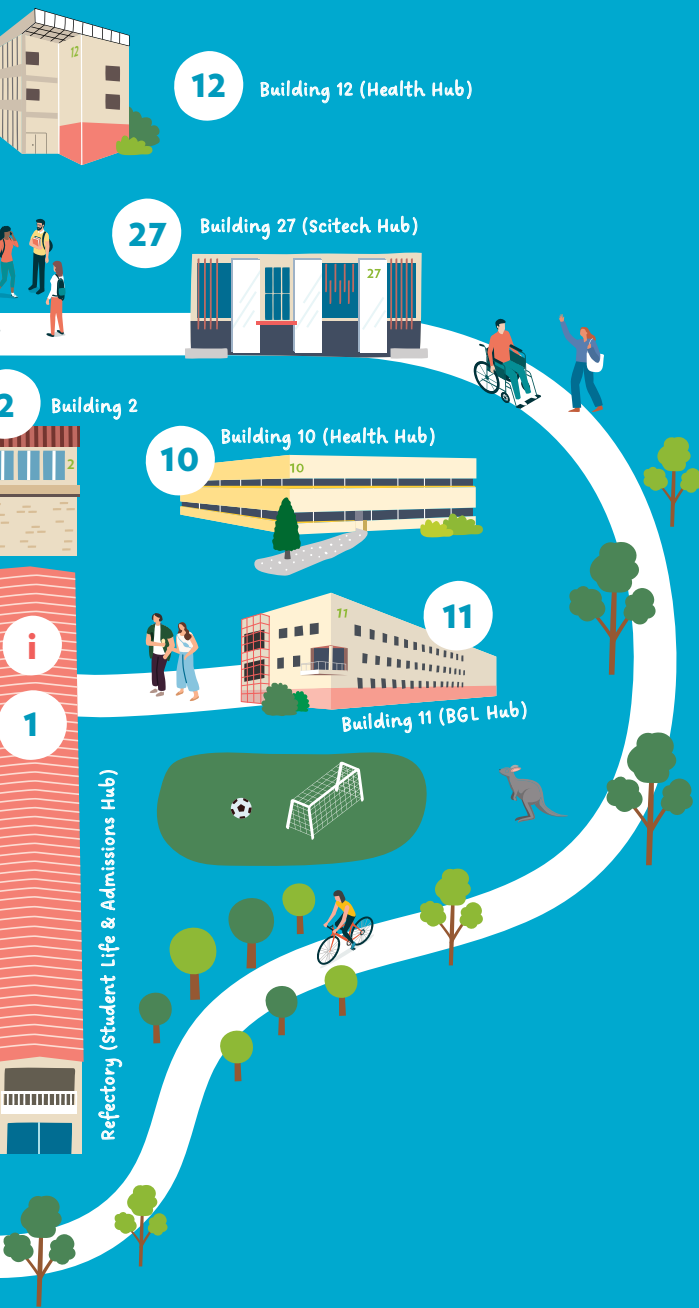

Non-tuition Costs

Depending on the course you're enrolled in and your units of study, you may encounter other costs.

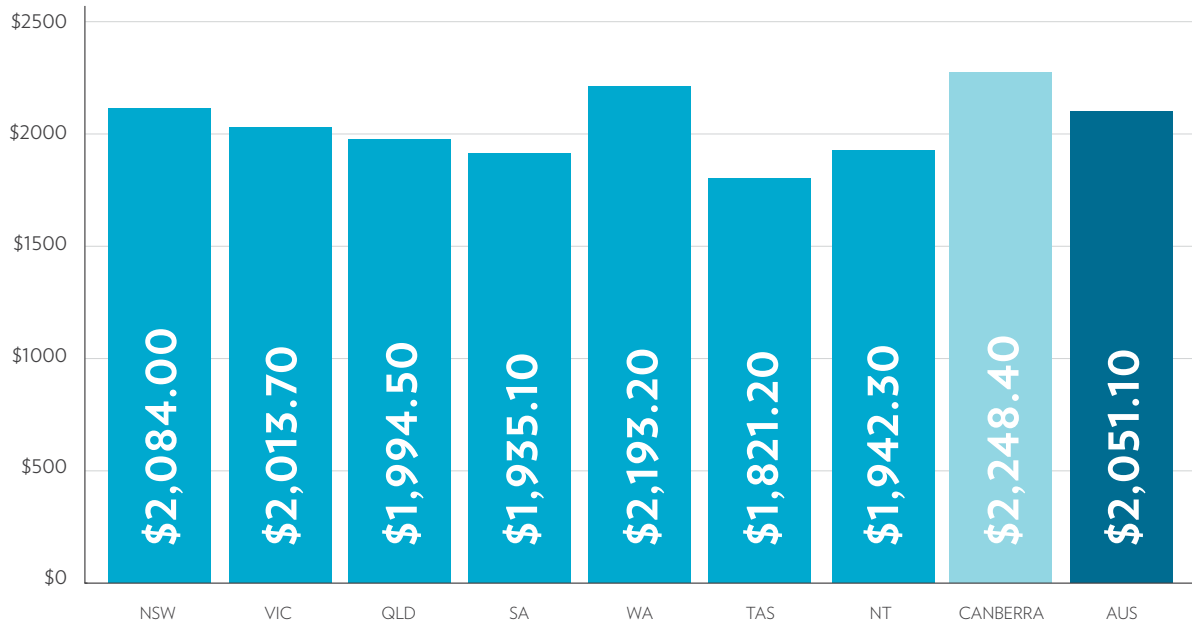

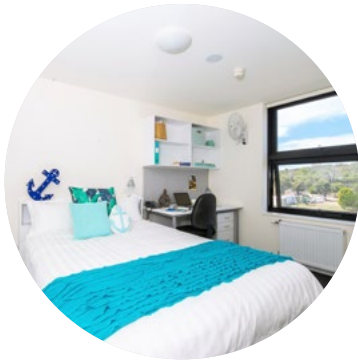

Campus Facilities



Canberra Behaviourial Lab (CanBe)

The CanBe Lab at the University of Canberra applies behavioural science and advanced tools to design programs that drive societal change. CanBe Lab works with government, business, and community partners to improve wellbeing, strengthen trust, and create healthier workplaces and services.

By combining behavioural insights with technologies like eye tracking, emotion analysis, and generative AI, the CanBe Lab tests interventions before rollout and measure real impact – helping partners co-design solutions that deliver lasting transformation.



UC Hospital

The University of Canberra Hospital (UCH): Specialist Centre for Rehabilitation, Recovery and Research is the largest purpose-built rehabilitation centre in the ACT and surrounding region, with capacity for 140 inpatient beds, 75-day places and additional outpatient services.

UCH features dedicated therapy spaces, including a hydrotherapy pool, therapeutic gyms, and kitchens to promote independence. There are also outdoor spaces, including a rehabilitation courtyard and recreational areas.

Students studying in the Faculty of Health will have classes in the new state-of-the-art Clinical Education and Research Centre (CERC) – the University's shared teaching and research space at the hospital.



Sporting Commons

Our sporting facilities are being developed on campus to help the University become one of Australia's leading tertiary sports institutions in scholarships and research. Facilities located within the Sporting Commons include gymnasiums, medical and rehabilitation areas, plunge pools, a sauna, a main oval and skills field, and a purpose-built bocce court for Special Olympics ACT.

The Sporting Commons are benefitting our students, with honours and doctoral students working alongside the Brumbies, the AIS and the University of Canberra Capitals to gain valuable experience while they study.

Study Skills Learning Advisors are available for support with understanding assessment tasks, structuring assignments, avoiding plagiarism, research and referencing.

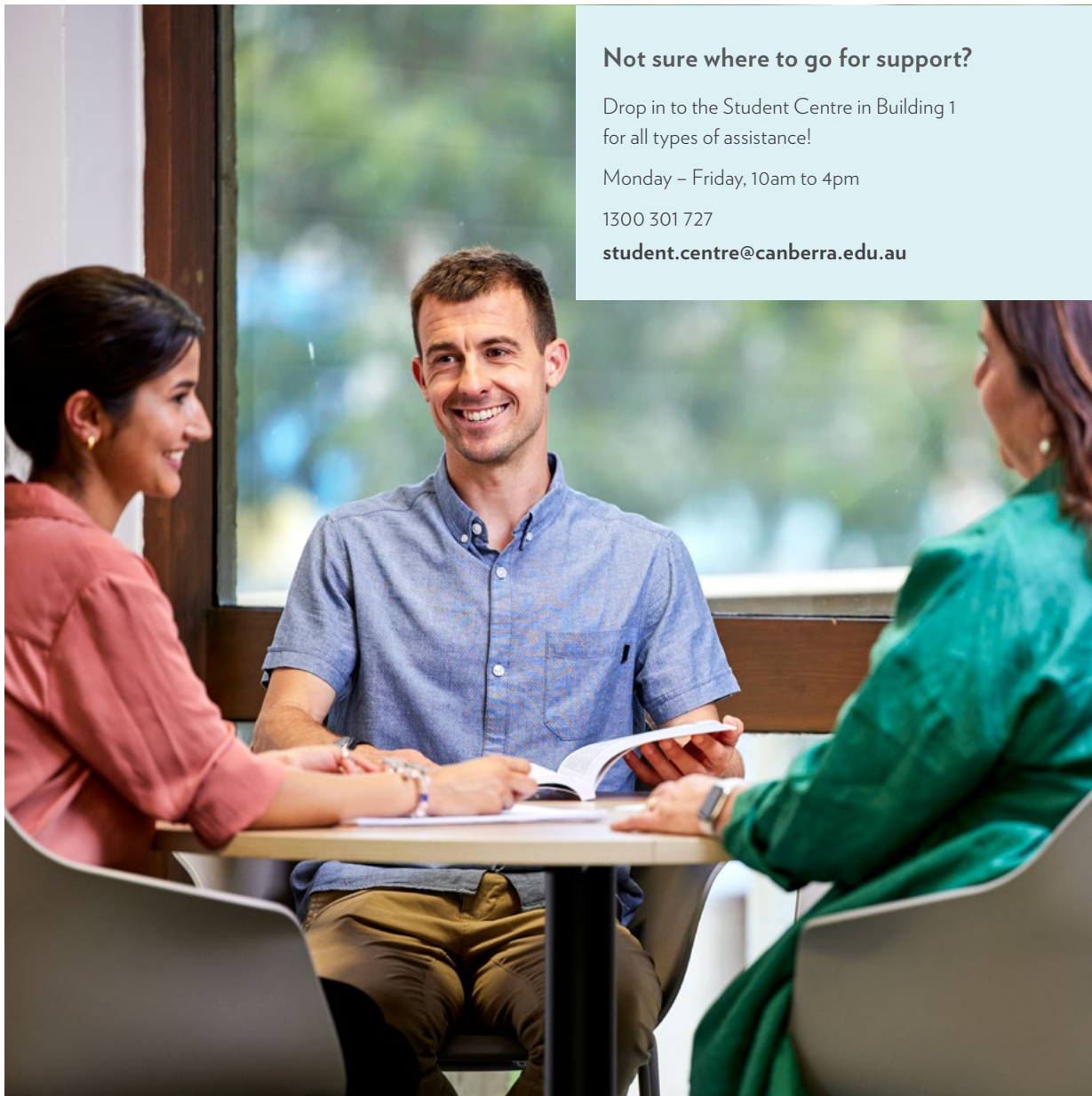
Peer-Assisted Learning Sessions (PALS)
