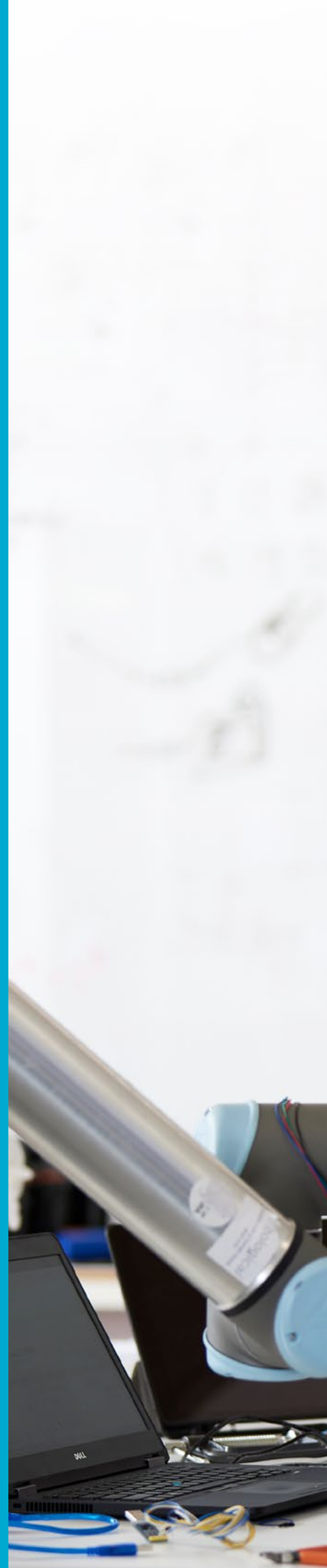

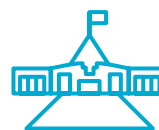




## GETTING AROUND IS EASY

# Student support

## ACADEMIC SUPPORT

### STUDY SKILLS

The UC Study Skills team helps you find solutions to any study related problems you may be having, which could include writing and grammar, researching and referencing, the structuring of assignments, maths and stats, intensive English courses and more.

### ALWAYS HERE

For 24/7 study help, the Study Help UCLearn site contains online interactive learning resources to help with finding information, referencing, assignment writing, maths and stats, time management, exam preparation, and more.

### PEER-ASSISTED LEARNING SESSIONS

Peer-Assisted Learning Sessions (PALS) offer extra learning and study support for traditionally difficult units. PALS leaders are past students who have successfully overcome the challenges in these units and have since received additional training to assist them in passing on their knowledge.

### MATHS AND STATS HELP

Drop-in Maths and Stats Help (MASH) sessions are held Monday to Friday in the MASH Centre. These are open to all students, with friendly tutors available to assist with a range of mathematics and statistics queries. There are also a range of online maths and stats learning modules available on the Study Help UCLearn site.

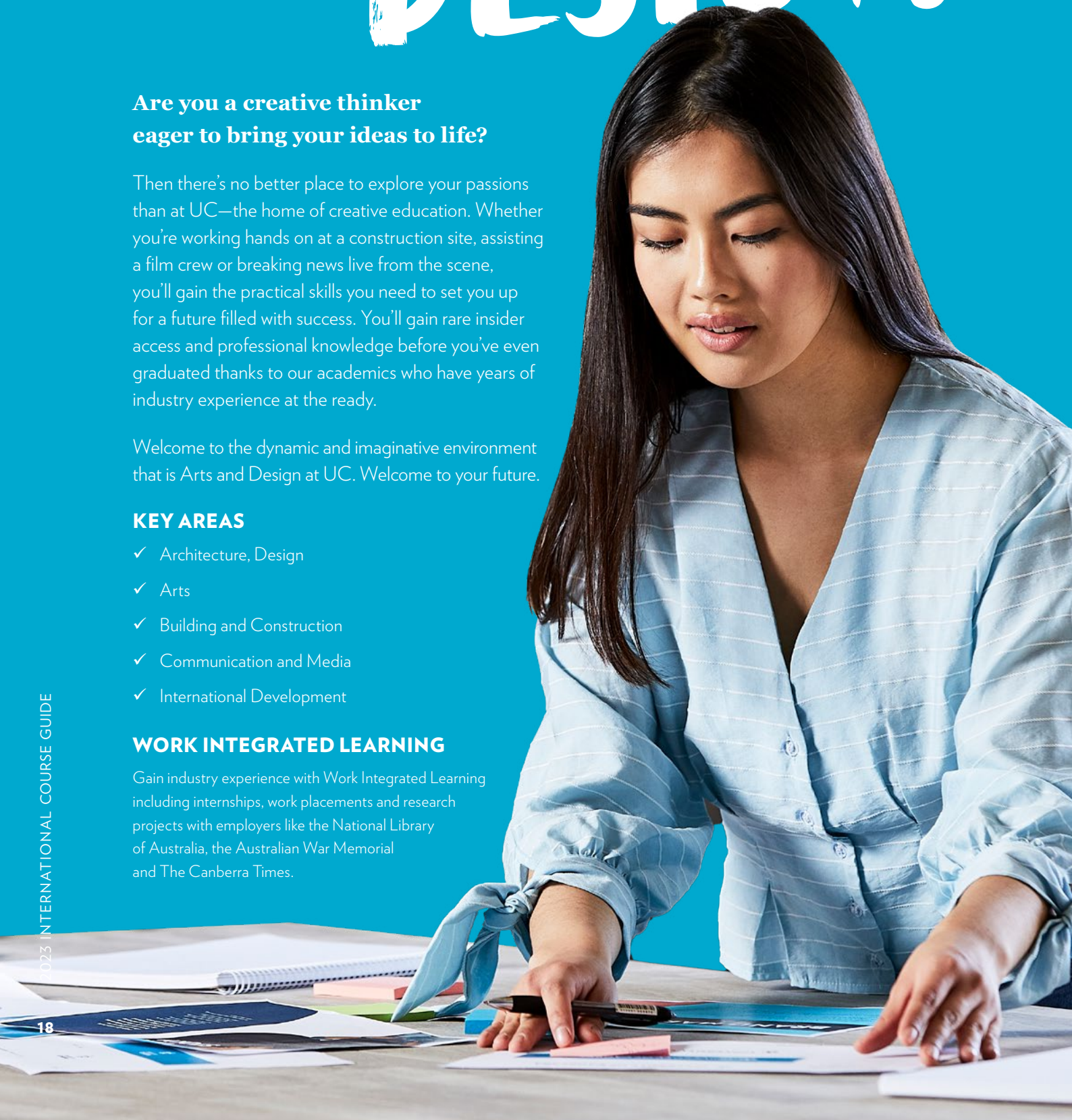

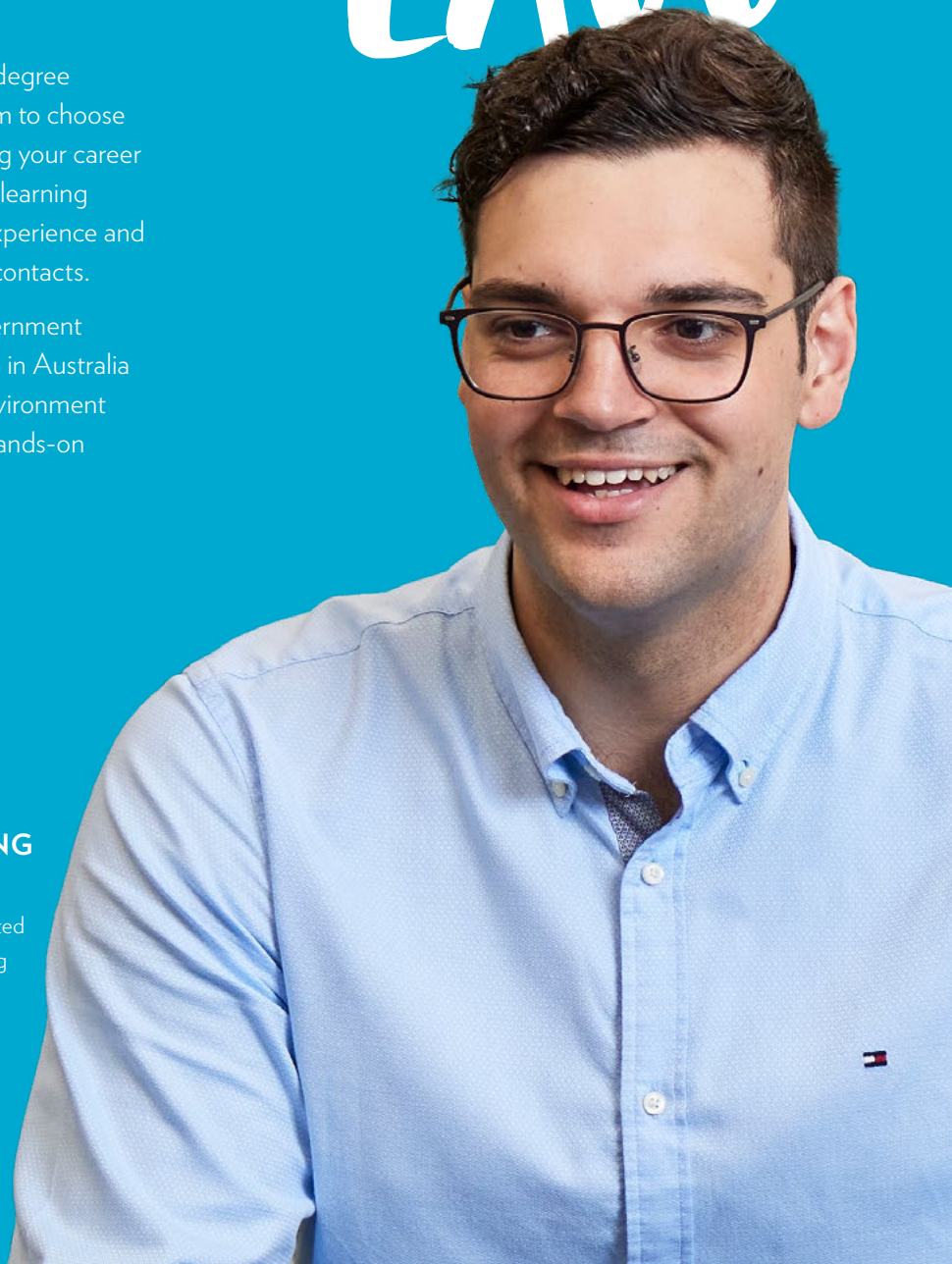

## UNDERSTAND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

### UC'S ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

When we assess your application for a UC degree, we consider different factors including your academic background and professional work experience. There are minimum qualifications you might need before we can make you an offer and UC recognises a range of qualifications from Australia and around the world for direct entry into our programs.

### UC'S ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS

There are a few ways you can prove your proficiency in English, namely through:

- Previous study in Australia or a recognised English-speaking country
- Prior study at a recognised institution or in a recognised qualification
- Through an English language test.

If you already met the language requirements through your previous studies, you won't need to take an English language test.

### OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- **Inherent requirements:** The knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to achieve the learning outcomes of your degree.
- **Genuine Temporary Entrant requirements (GTE):** You'll need to apply for a student visa and meet the visa conditions that allow you to stay in Australia to study. One of these conditions is to satisfy the GTE requirement as part of your application (this may be subject to your region).
