- Demonstrate initiative, kindness, patience, and willingness to engage with older people
- Meet all infection control requirements set by the residential care home while on-site

Internship requirements

- Attend a pre-unit workshop at the UC Hospital
- Complete orientation with the residential care home on-site
- Valid Working with Vulnerable People card
- National police check less than six months old
- COVID and Flu vaccination report
- Have means of transport to travel to on-site location
