

Early Offer Scheme – A step-by-step guide


1. Select a course

Scroll to the 'Start your application' section at the end of the <u>Early Offer webpage</u> to browse the undergraduate courses which are included in the Early Offer Scheme. You can filter these courses based on Faculty. Once you have selected your course, click on the 'Apply Now' link.

2. Register an account

You'll then be redirected to the University of Canberra's online application portal. From here, you will need to register an account. If you have already registered an account, you can simply login.

When registering your account, please ensure that you are using your personal email address rather than your school email. Otherwise, you will not receive emails from us once your school email address is made inactive.






3. Before you start!

Before you start your application, please ensure that you have a copy of your official Year 11 results and a 300 word personal statement explaining why you have chosen to apply for this course at the University of Canberra. Your Year 11 results must include a numeric or alphabetical grade which demonstrates your academic achievement for each subject.


Then, tick "Yes, I am eligible to apply for this course", and click "I am ready to apply!"






4. Next steps

You'll be required to fill out all mandatory questions, starting with your personal details. It is important that this information is accurate. Most importantly, you need to indicate that you are applying for the Early Offer Scheme by answering "Yes" to the "Are you applying for the Early Offer Scheme?" question.




Next fill in your contact details.


You will be required to select your course start date and campus. You must select **Semester 1 2025**. Click "Select Course Options".






A new window will pop up. You *may* be asked to select a Foundation Course and/or Diploma Course. Please note that this is not applicable to Early Offer Scheme applicants, so you can tick "No Foundation Course required" and "No Diploma Course required".








Then, click "Save All Courses".

Answer the Government Statistics and whether you need support services during your studies.

Next, you'll be required to fill in your secondary academic qualifications. This is where you can upload your Year 11 results and your 300 word statement. Your official Year 11 results must include a numeric or alphabetical grade which demonstrates your academic achievement for each subject.

Answer "Yes" to "Have you commenced or completed any secondary qualifications?", then fill in your qualification details, including the expected completion date.






It is not necessary to upload any other documents, so you can skip over the "Other Documents" section.

Then, you'll be required to read, understand, and agree to the applicant declaration. Tick "I have read and understood the above conditions and accept them fully", answer whether you'll be under 18 years of age at the time of commencement, then click "Save & Continue".



On the next page, you'll be given the chance to review your attachments, add comments about your application, and answer any questions that may have been missed. Once reviewed, click "Save & Continue".





5. Submit your application

Most importantly, don't forget to hit submit! Once you submit your application you will receive an email confirmation with your application number.
