Why do I need an IHI?

To have your vaccinations for clinical placement uploaded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), you will need an IHI (Individual Healthcare Identifier) number. (Your IHI number will be 16 digits long).

The quickest way to get an **IHI** is online through your <u>myGov account</u> (https://my.gov.au/). If you don't have an account, it's easy to <u>create one</u>

(https://my.gov.au/en/about/help/mygov-website/create-mygov-account) on the myGov website.

You'll need one of the following identification documents to upload to the website:

- your passport, with a valid Australian Visa
- your Australian driver licence.

These documents will be used to identify you. Follow these steps to get an IHI online:

Once you have your IHI number, please give this number to Reception staff at the UC Medical & Counselling Centre so that we can upload your vaccinations to the AIR (Australian Immunisation Register).
