Intangible

- "unable to be touched; not having physical presence"
- "difficult or impossible to define or understand; vague and abstract"
- "(Of an asset or benefit) not constituting or represented by a physical object and of a value not precisely measurable"



Value

 The regard that something is held to deserve; the importance, worth, or usefulness of something.



Tangible

'perceptible by touch'



Intangible Value – a short history and meaning

Intangible cultural values embodied in tangible heritage sites were increasingly recognized as an integral component of world heritage values. During my chairmanship [sic] of the World Heritage Committee, I had endeavoured to broaden the scope of 'heritage' to include intangible cultural values, be they spiritual or social, but there is an intrinsic limitation to the World Heritage Convention, which does not deal with intangible heritage as such. In practice, however, all tangible heritage embodies intangible components such as spiritual values, symbols, meanings, knowledge, or the know-how of craftsmanship [sic] and construction.

 - heritage definitions
 - Hierarchy of values
