Studying a UC Prep program will help improve your skills in research, report and essay writing, numeracy, oral presentations, time management, and learning online.

PROGRAM FEE

Free - the program is funded by the Commonwealth government. All students need to pay a student services and amenities fee.

Students can apply for an Education Bursary to attend in-person sessions and access essential resources.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is an open access course and has no formal academic requirement.

It is designed for students who are:

- 21 years or older
- Have been out of education for more than 2 years; and/or
- May have experienced hardship in their previous education.
- Completion of an Australian Year 10 or Year 12 (or equivalent) OR any other assessable qualification (Certificate III or above).
