UC PREP

FIRST YEAR UC UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

UC Prep is a bridging course that helps prepare you for study in a UC Degree. It is ideal for students who may have not studied for some time.

Studying a UC Prep program will help improve your skills in research, report and essay writing, numeracy, oral presentations, time management, and learning online.

14 weeks

February, May and September

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is an open access course and has no formal academic requirement.

It is designed for students who are:

- 21 years or older
- have been out of education for more than 2 years; and/or
- may have experienced hardship in their previous education.

Each application will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Note: Successful completion guarantees entry into the first year of the corresponding UC undergraduate degree.
