# UC Connect Enabling Pathway Program Offering

UC Connect developed by UC College in conjunction with the University of Canberra (UC) provides a pathway for current school leavers who wish to study an undergraduate degree at the UC and whose current academic qualifications do not allow them direct admission to the University.

You will study four preparation subjects that focus on the development of skills needed to successfully study at university:

- **Humanities** - prepares you for the content, style and subject matter of academic teaching and thinking.
- **Analytical methods** - develops your analytical thinking skills and your competence in solving mathematical problems.
- **Academic techniques** - teaches the practical skills you need to comply with university standards and expectations.
- **Numeracy and Digital Literacy** - learn via range of appropriate technologies to assist with your studies.

## Entry requirements

Completion of an equivalent Australian Year 12 qualification (education system of 12 years of schooling) with 3 passes in academic subjects. Successful completion guarantees entry into the first year of the corresponding UC Undergraduate degree.

Alternatively, students who need additional academic support will be guaranteed entry into a UC College Diploma program, which upon completion provides direct access to the second year of the corresponding UC Undergraduate degree.

- Semester 1 2027: 15 February 2027
- Semester 2: 09 August 2027
