AUBEA 2025 Doctoral Session: Presentation and Award Details

Research students are invited to present their thesis work in the **Doctoral Session** to an esteemed panel of expert, with the opportunity to showcase their academic contributions to a broader academic and professional community. This session enables participants to engage with leading figures in the field, receive insightful feedback, and refine their research through constructive critique.

Participants who wish to present their PhD research in this session will benefit in several ways:

- Clarify and Confirm Research Direction: Provides a structured opportunity to assess,
 validate, and align your research topic with current academic and industry trends.
- Enhance Research Process and Output: Facilitates in-depth discussion and peer/mentor feedback to improve your research design, methodology, and publication quality.
- Strengthen Thesis Evaluation Skills: Offers a platform to critically evaluate and review your own and others' research, enhancing academic rigor and examination readiness.
- Build Academic Network: Fosters connections with experienced scholars and fellow PhD
 candidates, creating opportunities for collaboration, mentorship, and future career
 development.

Participants will be selected for the session through a competitive process based on the abstract they submit. Please note that the abstract for this purpose should also be submitted during the abstract submission period. If the abstract is accepted, participants will have to present their PhD research by submitting a poster.

Requirements for Submission and Presentation

Participants are required submit a digital poster presenting their PhD research. Please use the **template available on our website** to create your poster. Participants will also be expected to deliver a **10-minute oral presentation** using the poster, followed by a 10-minute Q&A session.

Please note that the poster must be submitted through the Oxford paper submission portal during the conference paper submission period. The conference will offer free poster printing service.

In addition to the poster presentation, participants who wish to **publish a full paper** in the conference proceedings or supporting journals are welcome to submit a full paper. The full paper must also be submitted through the Oxford paper submission portal during the conference paper submission period.

Note: For all submissions intended to present at the Doctoral School, please use the theme 'CIB Doctoral School'.

Following the sessions, the panel of experts will select the recipients of both the **Outstanding Poster Award** and **Outstanding Oral Presentation Award**.
