

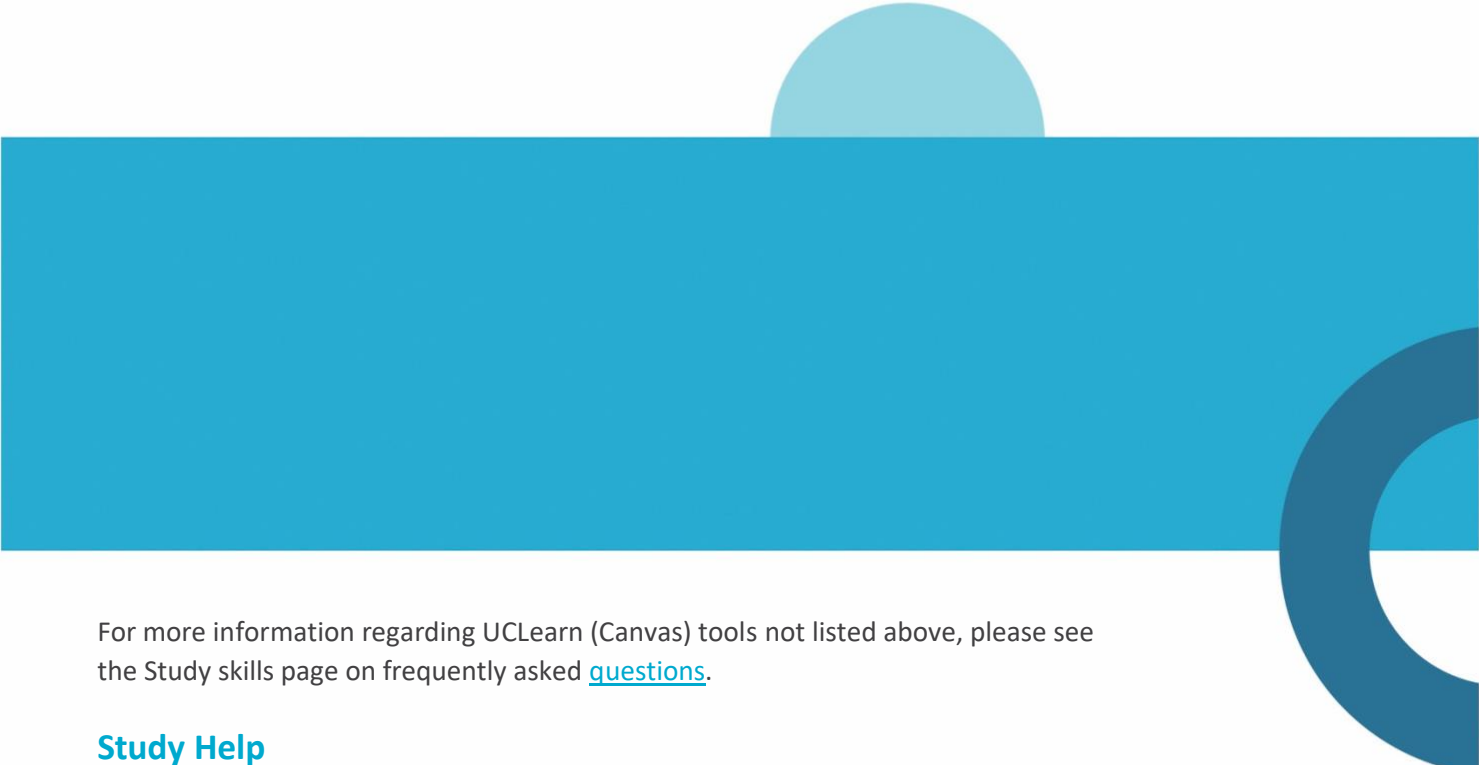
# UCLEARN (CANVAS) GUIDE FOR STUDENTS
