Location: Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

Duration: Six weeks - Summer Term 2020

Dates: 2nd January – 16th February 2020

UC Credit: 6 CPS internship unit

Costs: Program \$3650 + UC Tuition Cost

Inclusions: In country airport transfer, accommodation (shared bedroom), field visit from UC staff, language and cultural session, cultural field trips & activities and some meals.

Exclusions: Flights, most meals, visa, passport, transport to and from internship work placement and personal expenses.

Funding: New Colombo Plan Mobility Grants (\$3000) available for eligible students
OS-HELP Loans (up to \$8149) for eligible students.

Eligibility: Open to students with a minimum 4.5 GPA and are eligible to enroll into a suitable 6 CPS internship unit. Places will be awarded based on academic merit, written statement and interview performance.
