**Location:** Bangkok, Thailand

**Duration:** Six weeks Summer Term 2020

**Dates:** 4<sup>th</sup> January – 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020

**UC Credit:** 6 CPS internship unit

**Costs:** Program \$4250 + UC Tuition Cost

**Inclusions:** In country airport transfer, accommodation (shared bedroom), field visit from UC staff, intensive language and cultural session, three cultural field trips and some meals

**Exclusions:** Flights, most meals, visa, passport, transport to and from internship work placement, and personal expenses

**Funding:** New Colombo Plan Mobility Grants (\$3000) available for eligible students  
OS-HELP Loans (up to \$8149) for eligible students

**Eligibility:** Open to students with a minimum 4.5 GPA and are eligible to enroll into a suitable 6 CPS internship unit. Places will be awarded based on academic merit, written statement and interview performance.
