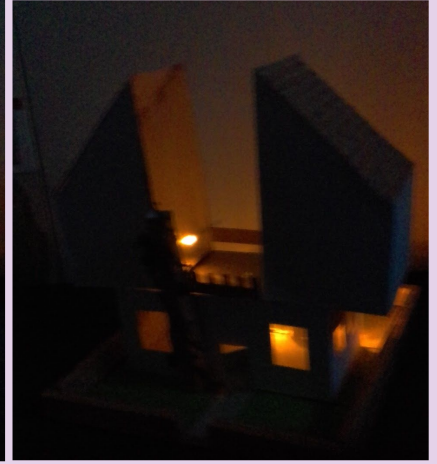


Deconstructed Cottage
