

# Outstanding Team Achievement in Research or Enterprise

## Preamble

The award for Outstanding Team Achievement in Research or Enterprise recognises outstanding team contributions to the research and enterprise performance of the university over the past 12 months. The selection criteria include:

For research teams:

- 1. Evidence of achievement in terms of research income, output, and outcomes
- 2. Evidence of recognition by external peers or in national or international ratings or ranking systems
- 3. Evidence of impact of research through commercial returns, policy impact, social or environmental impact

For research support teams:

- 1. Evidence of support for research and enterprise activities that go beyond expected responsibilities.
- 2. Evidence of the introduction of new and innovative approaches to research and innovation support that have yielded demonstratable outcomes.

# The Award

The winning team will receive \$2,500 which can be used to support further team research or innovation activities. The prize money will be allocated for the 2024 calendar year and funds will need to be expended by 30 November 2024. Funds cannot be carried over to 2025.

# Eligibility

Teams of UC academic and/or professional staff who are directly engaged in either academic research or innovation or in supporting the conduct of research and innovation at this university are eligible.



#### **Selection Process**

Nominations will be sought from Executive Deans, Deputy Deans, Institute and Centre Directors, Deputy Directors, and Associate Deans Research. Nominations must include:

- Completed nomination cover sheet; and
- A statement of up to 2 pages addressing, with evidence, the relevant selection criteria as outlined in the preamble.

#### **Award Recipients**

The winner of the Outstanding Team Achievement in Research or Enterprise award will be announced at the University awards ceremony in November. The winner will be a finalist for the Vice-Chancellors Researcher of the Year award.

Winners will be required to submit a brief report to the Office of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor Research and Enterprise (<u>DVCRE@canberra.edu.au</u>) on their use of the funds by 31 January 2025.

This should detail:

- How the award has assisted in engagement and impact activities for their research.
- Details of engagement and impact outputs arising from activities funded by the award.
- An acquittal of expenditure of the funds.

#### **Submission**

Nominations must be submitted via email in <u>one single pdf</u> to <u>DVCRE@canberra.edu.au</u> by 5:00pm AEST 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Late nominations will not be accepted.
